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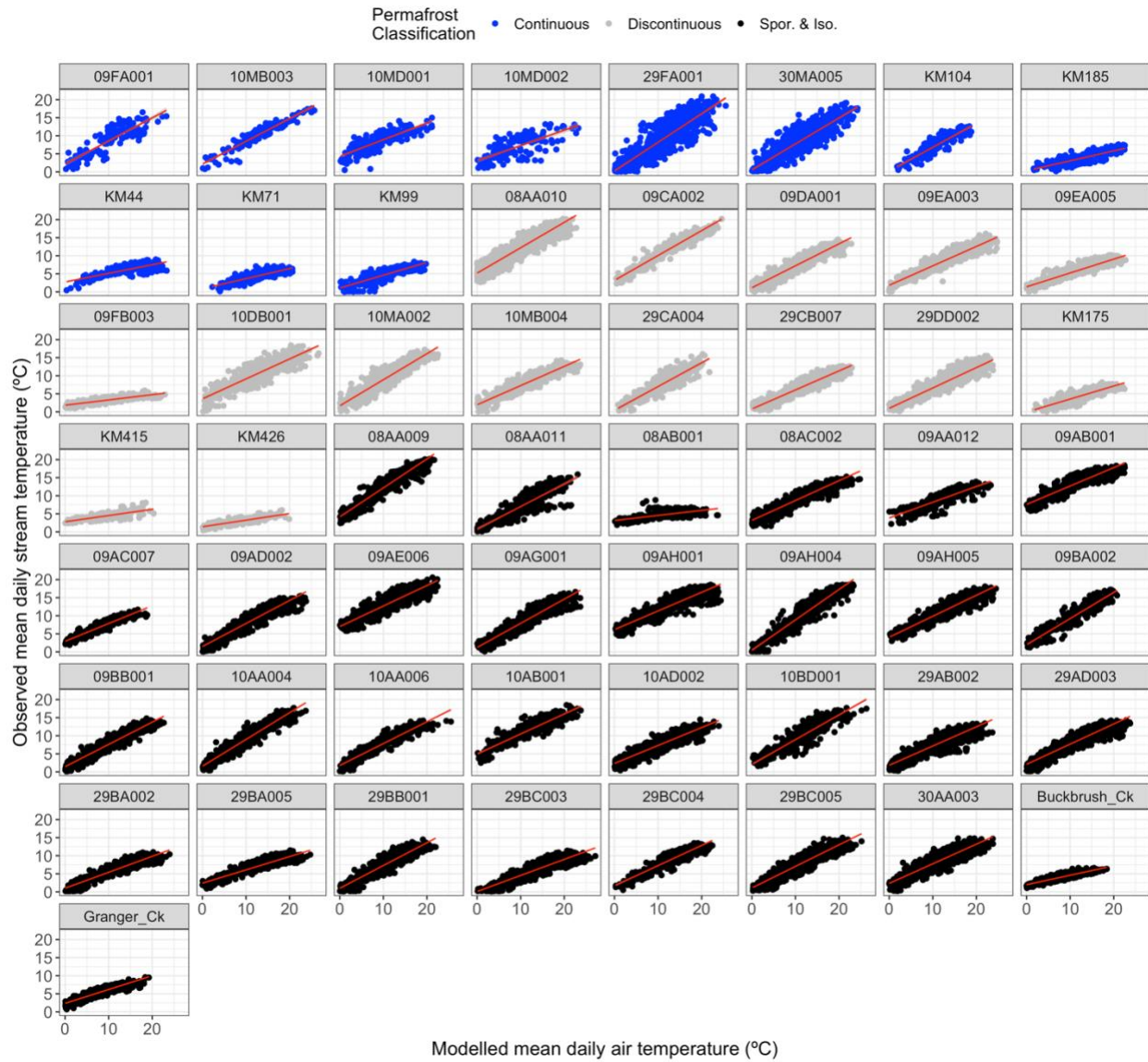


Figure S1: Observed mean daily streamflow vs. modelled mean daily air temperature for the 57 study sites. The red lines are a linear regression, the slope of which is the ‘thermal sensitivity’ coefficient, and the intercept is the ‘baseline temperature’. The sites are grouped and coloured by permafrost classification.
