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It is my opinion that this paper presents findings that is important to water resource management and hydrologists in the region and as such warrants publication. However in its current form the paper suffers from a lack of structure and direction. I thought the paper was long-winded in parts and very difficult to follow. A clear structure and extensive editing are needed to strengthen the manuscript. The manuscript needs to also provide more detail on its methods and even though it presents its findings reasonably well it does suffer from not having a clear structure to the findings. It also does not adequately critically discuss the findings in context.

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
