Please, be also careful for subscripts in the text (Gs and Sr - line 201) and superscripts in the text (i.e. for units of transmissivity (m<sup>2</sup>/d) in Table 2, or for square/cubic meters - lines 198, 199).

With regard to the reviewers' comments and suggestions, I would recommend to add the word "shallow" to the paper's title, so that it will be more clear, which types of landslides you have analyses in the study.
