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Nitrate contamination in irrigated stream-aquifer systems is a serious problem in agricultural watershed. Numerical modelling and relevant sensitivity analysis are important methods for understanding of nitrogen fate and transport, as well as making remediation strategies. This study used a nitrogen fate and transport groundwater model and the revised Morris sensitivity analysis method to identify the spatially-varying influence of system factors on nitrate fate and transport in a regional-scale irrigated hydro-agricultural system.
