This is a good summary paper of a field campaign EAGLE 2006. This kind of paper is really needed in this kind interdisciplinary research as the focal point. Necessary information is comprehensively described and sentences are well written and easy to read. Thus, I recommend this paper for publication with minor revision.

If there would be shortages, they are as follows:

- 1) Although the authors kindly give a list of acronyms in Appendix A, appropriate references are desirable for some acronyms especially those for satellite sensors to enable readers to get further information.
- 2) General weather condition throughout the 11 days campaign and the timing of air-  
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borne measurements and satellite snaps should be described together, which are helpful to readers and are also to related researchers referring to this paper as focal point.

3) The Figure 7 should be clearer. The ‘gray’ line is not discernible.

4) Spelling . . . P1803, line 12: ‘has be’ => ‘has been’ P1811, line 12: ‘trajectory’ => ‘optical path’
