Thank you for your comment. The model developed in this study is valid for nonreactive chemicals (i.e. bromide, chloride, etc.). It is not valid for a reactive chemical since adsorption of reactive chemicals delays transport of chemical in pores. The model can be used to determine effective pore size distribution in any porous medium that yield a breakthrough curve of a nonrective chemical. Therefore, the model can be used with clay soils. However, completing a miscible displacement test on a clay column may take very long time.
