

Interactive comment on “Multiple domain evaluation of watershed hydrology models” by Karthik Kumarasamy and Patrick Belmont

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The paper deals with the topics which has already received a lot of attention in the literature: a) how to evaluate models best, and b) how to arrange calibration process best. Widely used 'squared-difference based' metirics (eg RMSE) have been shown to suffer from deficiencies, and the authors continue this theme - which still require attention of researchers. The referees recognise that, but have come with quite a number of comments - in my view very thoughtful and useful, and referring to more previously published research. These comments have been comprehensively addressed in the authors' responses. The paper has to be revised, and the authors are invited to do it.

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
