The number of analyzes of rainwater quality was dependent on the nature of precipitation (its intensity and precipitation time). In Table 1, the first row gives the number of all rainy events - also very short and not very intense ones. However, the specificity of the rainfall did not always allow the use of the adopted sampling methodology.
