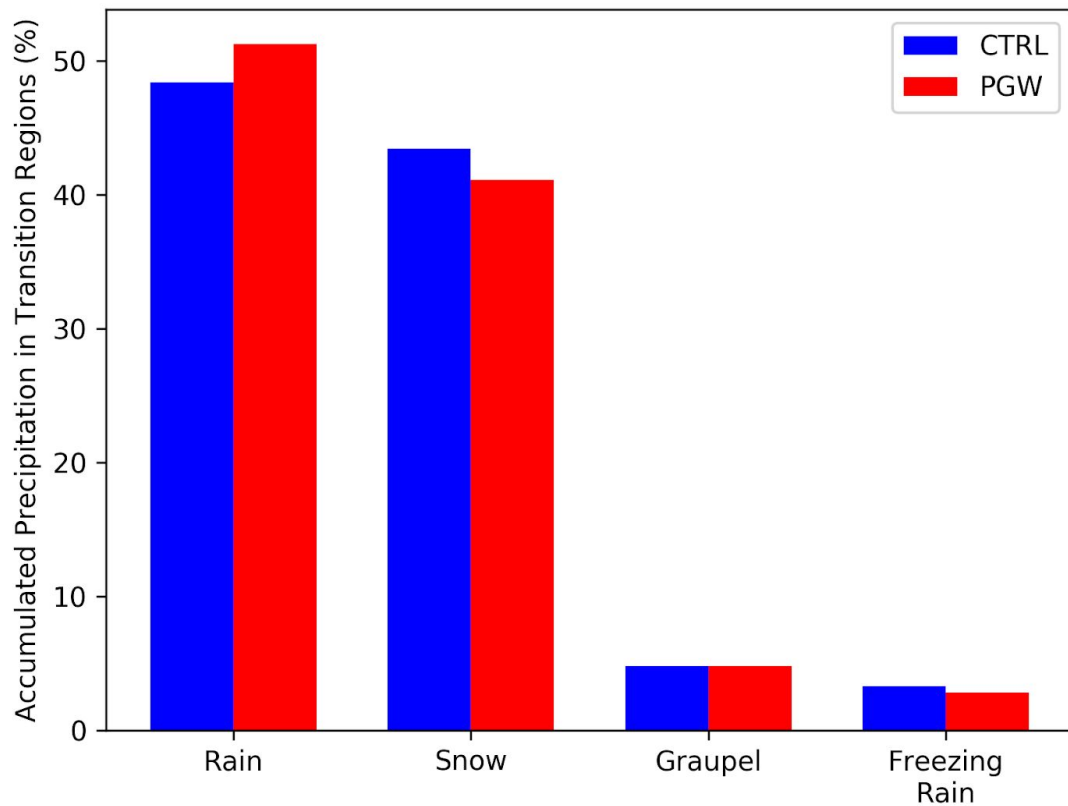
Thank you for explaining the process. Here is a detailed explanation of the changes that can be forwarded to the editor.

Upon reviewing the proofread, I noticed that I had sent the wrong version of Figure 8 upon first submission. Consequently, there are some slight changes to the text and caption regarding the figure as described below.

(a) Specifically, the proportion of precipitation constituents within the transition region requires revision. Some changes were made to the criterion of the transition region before the original submission of the manuscript, but the consequent impacts on proportions were mistakenly not changed in the actual text.

The text should read as follows, with the highlighted portions denoting the changes: “There was a shift in the distribution of accumulated precipitation types within transition regions from CTRL to PGW (Fig. 8). The proportion of snow decreased from 43.5% (CTRL) to 41.1% (PGW), corresponding with an increase in rain, from 48.4% (CTRL) to 51.3% (PGW). The proportion of graupel remained the same, at 4.8%. There was a small decrease in the proportion of freezing rain, from 3.3% (CTRL) to 2.8% (PGW).”
